Changed traffic conditions: Hume Highway at Kyeamba Hill (Stage 2)

The Northern Hume Alliance, a team consisting of the RTA, Leighton Contractors, Maunsell AECOM, Coffey Partners and Snowy Mountains Engineering Corporation (SMEC) has been engaged to design and construct the duplication of four sections of the Hume Highway from the Sturt Highway to Holbrook by the end of 2009.

In February 2009 all traffic at Kyeamba Hill was switched onto the new southbound carriageway of the Hume Highway.

This required changes to traffic movements on Tumbarumba Road to allow work to commence on the new northbound carriageway.

The second stage of a temporary traffic switch at Kyeamba Hill is scheduled to occur on Wednesday 1 April 2009.

This will allow completion of upgrade works on the Tumbarumba to Wagga Road.

Traffic arrangements will be as follows:

- Motorists travelling from **Tumbarumba to Wagga Wagga** will continue along Tumbarumba Road and across Tumbarumba Road Bridge. Motorists will then travel south along the old Hume Highway, turn left onto the new carriageway and then exit left approximately 700 metres north of the bridge to continue to Wagga Wagga.
- Motorists travelling from **Wagga Wagga to Tumbarumba** will turn right from Tumbarumba Road onto the new carriageway and then exit left immediately to continue onto Tumbarumba Road via the new off-ramp.
- Motorists travelling from **Tumbarumba to Melbourne** will continue to turn left from Tumbarumba Road onto the new carriageway via a new on-ramp.
- Traffic travelling from **Tumbarumba to Sydney** will continue along Tumbarumba Road, and across Tumbarumba Road Bridge. Motorists will then travel south along the old Hume Highway and turn left onto the new carriageway to continue north to Sydney.
